# What you will do here

The agenda of the first two months is focused on the renovation and arrangement of the Volunteer Center, the volunteers, after acquiring the necessary skills, will work under the supervision of the coordinator to make that space a welcoming, non-formal and useful for young people to come to activities carried out later . The next months are practically the essence of the project, namely after the launch of the Volunteer Center, developing activities, promoting and managing the Center, organizing events  
The volunteers will be divided in 4 teams ( 4 international +1 in country each team ) and they will monthly rotate with a weekly leader who is responsible to share the task for his own team



# ESC Organizational aspects

**Volunteers will have to sign an agreement where are stipulated their tasks, rights and responsibilities.**



Volunteers will be guided in the activities by a coordinator and assigned a mentor, weekly meetings are encouraged to be attended in order to evaluate the learning process. Volunteers will be assisted to register to OAT and MTM (organized by NA) where is mandatory to take part



Volunteers will be offered a travel support according to the travel band distance. Volunteers will receive local transport pass



Working hours: 7 hours / day; 5 days a week. Free days: 2 per month, free declared Holydays will be applied also



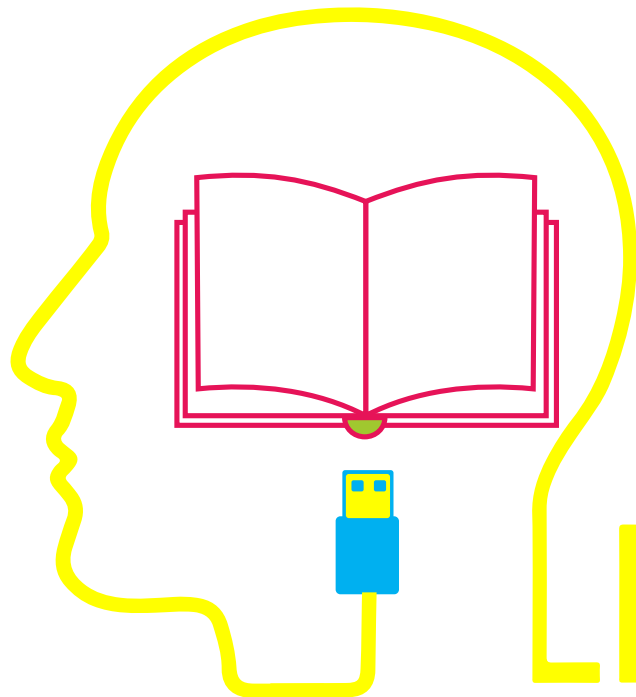
Volunteers will receive a sim card



Volunteers will receive a monthly food allowance of 150 euros and 90 euro pocket money in Lei (Romanian currency)

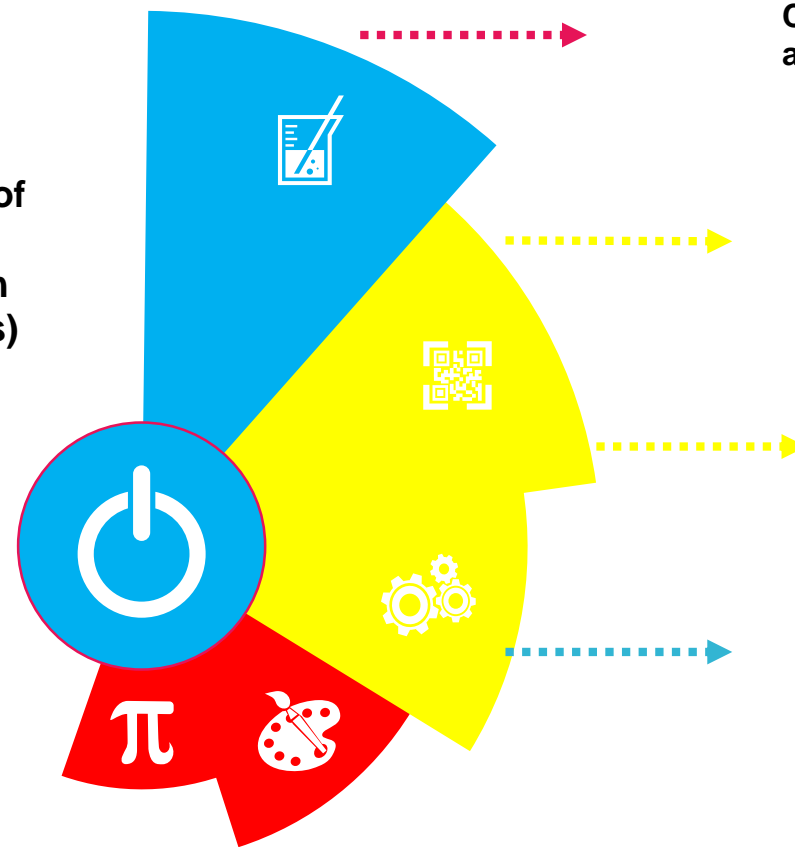

# Accommodation

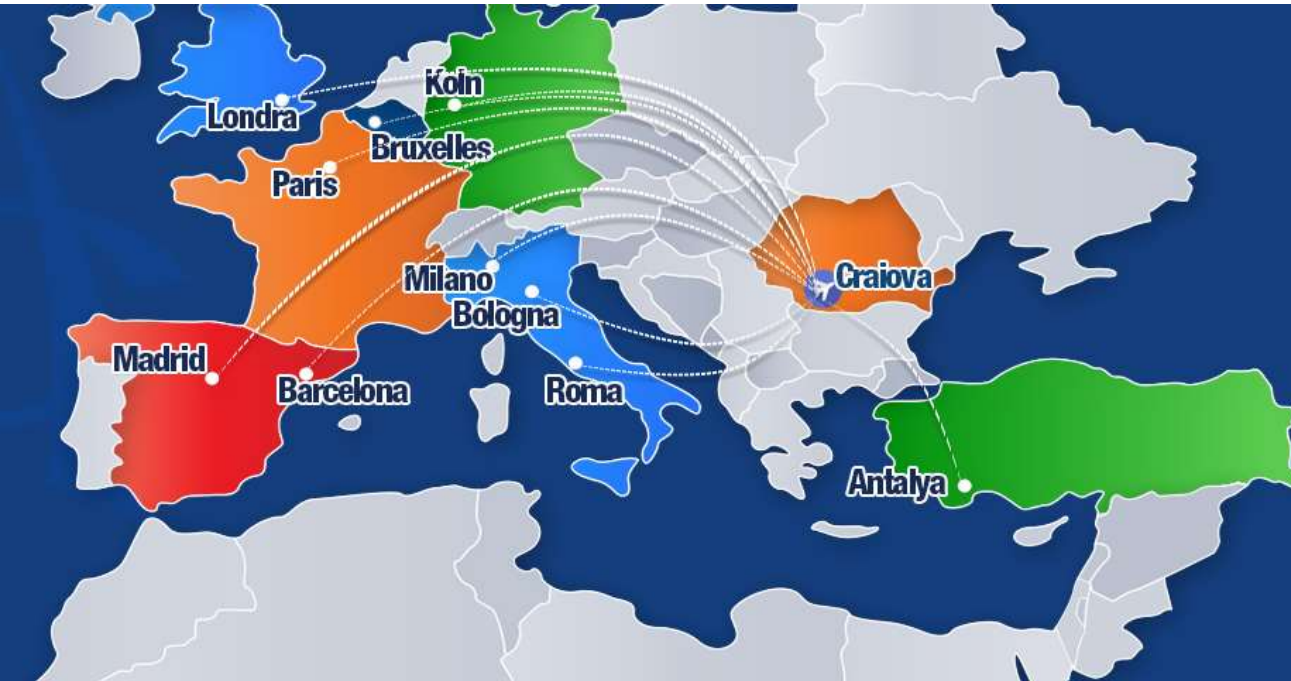
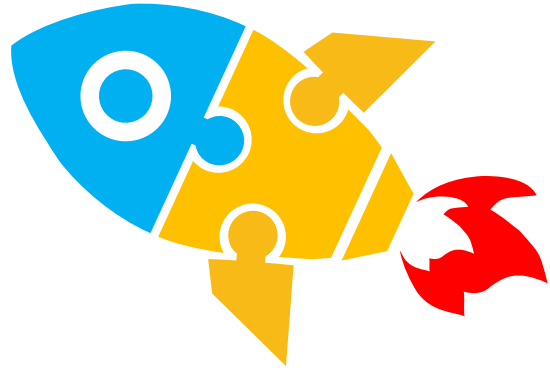


Volunteers will be accommodated in rented appartaments, 2 in the room , same gender room with common kitchen and shared bathroom
