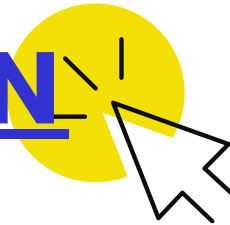

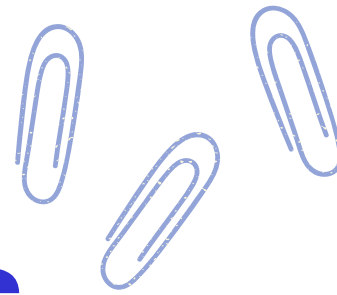

PARTICIPANT TASKS

- Assist in the management of NGOs, particularly in writing European projects within the Erasmus+ framework (training will be provided).
- Design, prepare and maintain the community garden.
- Engage in artistic activities to enhance the visual appeal of the facilities.
- Co-organize exhibitions, festivals, conferences, interviews, workshops and other events.
- Participate in language classes using non-formal methodologies.
- Organize cultural activities based on your experiences and traditions.
- Promote European values, such as solidarity, environmental care and volunteerism.
- Foster positive relationships with the local community by engaging in local activities.
- Share the outcomes of volunteering on various social media platforms: Facebook, Instagram, Tik Tok, blog, website, etc.



PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS



- Maximum weekly work commitment of 35 hours a week, inclusive of language classes, job preparation and workshops.

 - Volunteers are responsible for their own meals. A daily budget of €5 is allocated for the purchase of essential food items.

A standard week is structured from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Recognizing the significance of personal time and rest, we employ a rotation system for all team members, the details of which will be comprehensively presented during your induction.

We prioritize work-life balance, ensuring volunteers have two rest days weekly, typically on Saturday and Sunday, and are allocated a maximum workload of 35 hours per week. Furthermore, all SVE volunteers are entitled to 22 official holidays throughout their 11-month placement, supplemented by Spain's national holidays.

Engaging in Permacultura Cantabria's daily life involves active participation in various facets of our operations, from routine maintenance such as cleaning and gardening, to upholding the excellence we're known for across all functions. Volunteers immerse themselves in ecological endeavors, nurturing our gardens, contributing to environmental sustainability, and participating in creative artistic projects spanning disciplines such as music, theater, and visual arts.

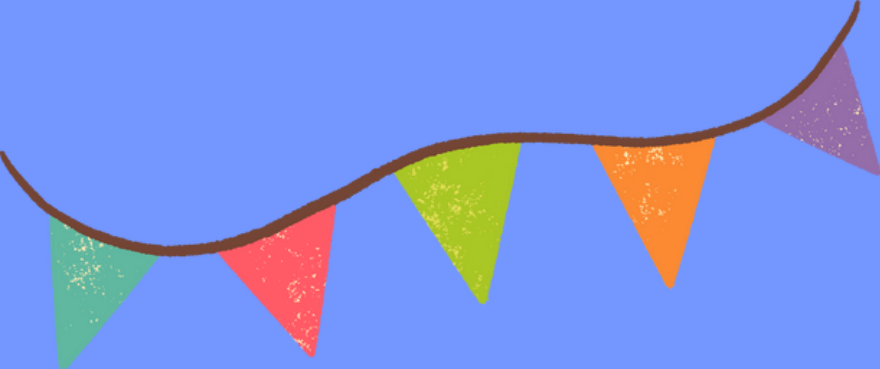

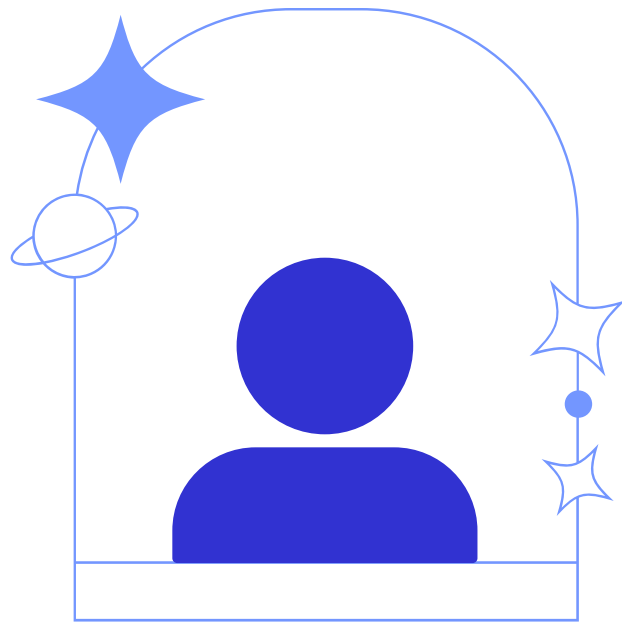

★ ACCOMODATION DETAILS

We provide accommodations in two esteemed establishments, Pensión Los Rosales and Pensión El Ferial, located in the town of Sarón. Both venues offer comfortable living spaces and are conveniently situated within a five-minute distance from each other. These lodgings are central and accessible, with a range of amenities including grocery stores, cinemas, post offices, sports facilities, pubs, and dining options, all within walking distance. The main center of Permacultura Cantabria, where EVS volunteering takes place, and the on-site restaurant are located in El Ferial facilities.

★ SHARED FACILITETES

Within both accommodations, we offer common living rooms, laundry facilities, and fully equipped kitchens featuring refrigerators, freezers, ovens, microwaves, and garden access. Wi-Fi internet connectivity is accessible both at the Center and in your accommodations. Volunteers may opt for shared or single rooms, with communal bathroom facilities. It is expected that all residents maintain the cleanliness and orderliness of their rooms and shared spaces on a daily, weekly, and monthly basis.



★ RESPONSIBLE COMMUNITY LIVING:

Respect for Property: Please refrain from causing damage to any property or its contents. Modifying or adding items (such as posters on walls) is not permitted.

Maintenance of Interior: Ensure that the interior of the property is kept in good condition, clean, and habitable. Volunteers are responsible for any necessary cleaning costs to restore the property to its original state.

Noise Consideration: Out of respect for fellow residents, kindly avoid making noise between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. Noise disturbances should be minimized during other hours as well.

Non-Smoking Environment: We prioritize non-smokers; however, designated outdoor smoking areas are available. Cigarette butts should be properly disposed of in ashtrays.



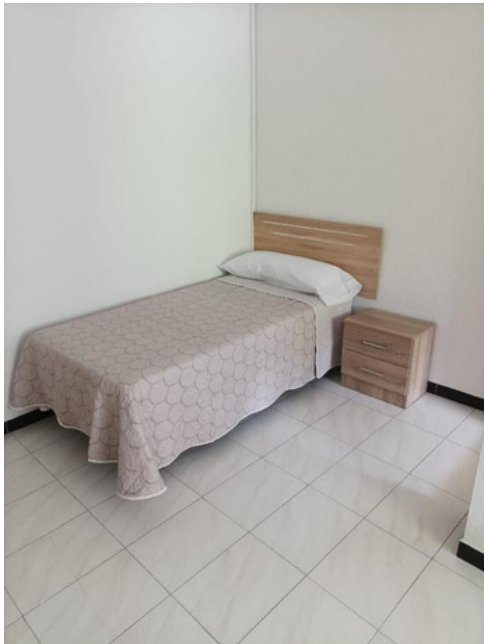
Waste Management: Dispose of all garbage (regular, recycling, and compost) daily in the outside containers. Do not leave garbage bags in rooms or common areas.

Fire Safety: Keep hallways clear and unobstructed, as blocked pathways pose a fire safety risk.

Utility Controls: Avoid adjusting heating controls or thermostats; these are regulated centrally by staff.

Energy Conservation: Conserve energy by turning off lights and electronic devices when not in use.

Community Cleaning: Participate in weekly collective cleaning sessions and monthly deep cleaning efforts.



★ PERSONAL SPACES

Room Maintenance: Volunteers are responsible for cleaning and tidying their rooms and bathrooms. Rooms should be kept tidy and clean each morning.

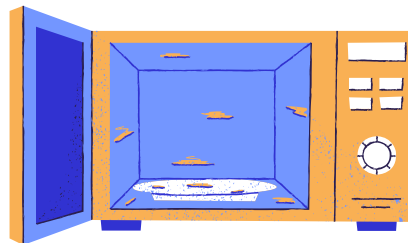
Bathroom Etiquette: Do not flush non-organic items down the toilet. Please dispose of hair properly after showers to prevent drainage issues.

Electrical Devices: Turn off all lights and electrical devices when leaving your room.

Kitchen and Laundry Etiquette:

Kitchen Usage: Keep the kitchen clean after meals, including oven and stove cleanup, dishwashing, sweeping the floor, and storing leftovers.

Laundry Practices: Use washing machines efficiently and pick up your clothes promptly to allow others to use the laundry room. Return laundry baskets to the laundry area after use.

Community Responsibility: Maintain common areas and bedrooms to high cleanliness standards as visitors and Permacultura Cantabria team members may occasionally visit.

Energy Usage: Excessive energy consumption may result in additional charges shared among residents. Visitors are not permitted to spend the night in the accommodations.

If you think you've packed everything... **THINK AGAIN!** Consult the list of items you'll need to bring.

★ SHARED ACCOMMODATIONS:

You might share your room with other individuals of the same gender but different nationalities. A set of towels and bed linens will be provided, and it is your responsibility to maintain them throughout your stay.

★ STAY IN SPAIN:

Please note that Permacultura Cantabria will not offer additional accommodation for your stay in Spain outside your volunteer dates. If you plan to arrive earlier and/or stay after the project's activity period, kindly inform us as soon as possible.

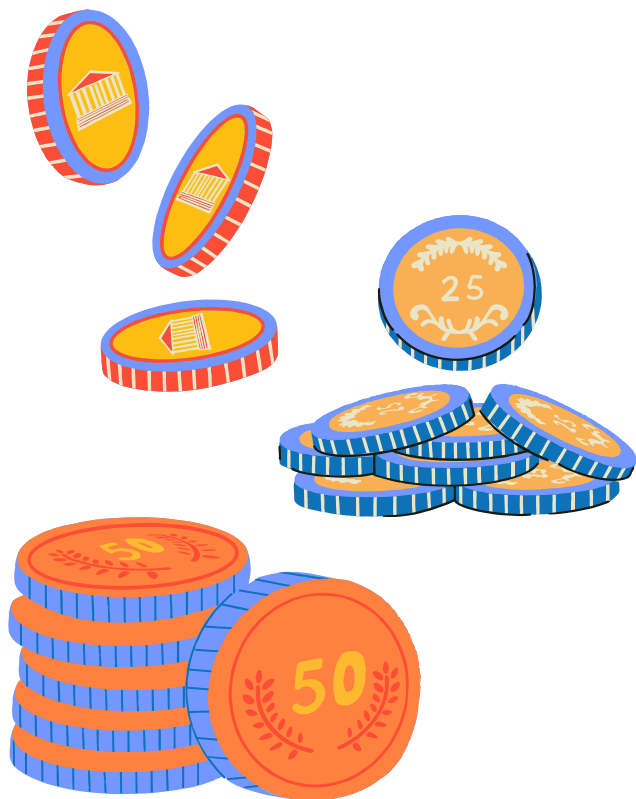
★ WIFI AND COMPUTING DEVICES:

We offer wireless internet access at Permacultura Cantabria, as well as at Pensión Los Rosales and Pensión El Ferial. If you bring your own device/laptop, please ensure you have your personal power adapter compatible with Spanish outlets. While outlets in Spain are generally standard, it's advisable to be prepared.

★ IMPORTANT NOTICE:

The weather in Cantabria can be highly unpredictable. Therefore, bring warm clothing to stay comfortable both during work and at home. Additionally, we recommend bringing an extra pair of appropriate outdoor shoes or boots, as the picturesque Cantabrian countryside is nearby, and you'll undoubtedly find them essential!


REIMBURSEMENT OF TRAVEL COSTS



Sending organization reimburses 100% of eligible travel costs (within the maximum limits set by the Erasmus+ travel distance bands, which is €275 for the route from Poland to Spain). Additionally, please consider the following details:

Reimbursement will be processed exclusively upon presentation of original tickets to the Permacultura Cantabria project team. Please retain all original tickets related to travel expenses.

For flight reimbursements, the tickets and invoices must be original, indicating the passenger(s) name, flight dates, departure and arrival locations, airline, and price. Other types of tickets should include the route, date, and travel cost.


If you booked your flight online with EasyJet, Wizzair, Ryanair, we require the official email confirming your booking, which should also include your name, route, and price.

Kindly preserve the original confirmation email of your online booking, along with the printed itinerary displaying the date and time. Please also retain the email sent to you by the travel company. Don't forget to keep your boarding passes.

Travel expenses incurred outside the project dates will only be reimbursed if approved by the Permacultura Cantabria project team.

Both the Sending and Receiving organizations are available to assist the volunteer with any inquiries that may arise.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



★ WHO HANDLES THE PURCHASE OF AIRPLANE TICKETS?

Once you have been confirmed as a participant in the exchange program, it is your responsibility to arrange and purchase your own flight. We provide a maximum budget of €275 to assist you with this purchase. To facilitate the reimbursement process, it is imperative that you retain both your airplane ticket and boarding pass. Please scan these documents immediately after your journey and email them to us to ensure they are not misplaced.

★ WHEN WILL THE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE FLIGHT PURCHASE BE PROCESSED?

The reimbursement will be processed after the completion of your stay in Spain. This procedure ensures your sustained interest and participation. It is essential to maintain all relevant documents accurately, as we will require them to verify your travel expenses.

★ ARE THERE SCHOLARSHIPS OR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AVAILABLE?

Yes, you will receive €150 per month (€5 per day) to assist with your daily expenses. This "pocket money" will be transferred directly to the bank account you provide. Payments will be made in Zlotys directly from sending organization and will be adjusted based on the exact number of days you have stayed. For example, if you arrive in the middle of the first month and stay for 15 days, you will receive €60 (15 days × €5 per day). If you stay for the entire month of 31 days, you will receive €155.

★ WHEN WILL I RECEIVE THE POCKET MONEY?

The pocket money will be deposited into your bank account during the first 5 days of each subsequent month. For instance, if you stayed for the entire month of January (31 days), you are entitled to €155, which will be transferred to your bank account during the first five days of February.

★ WHAT TYPE OF INSURANCE COVERAGE DO I HAVE?

As the hosting organization, we provide liability and accident insurance for all participants, in addition to the standard insurance provided by CES (...). We also recommend obtaining a European Health Insurance Card, which allows you to access the Spanish healthcare system without any complications.

★ WILL THERE BE ANY SUPPORT OR SUPERVISION PROVIDED?

During your stay, you will have a dedicated mentor responsible for coordinating tasks, activities, schedules, evaluations, and training sessions. This mentor will assist you with any requirements to ensure your stay is both successful and secure.



★ WHAT ACTIVITIES WILL I BE ENGAGED IN DURING MY STAY?

The activities you participate in will be tailored to your interests. Our organization has a dedicated team to assist you in developing your skills and interests. Some of our common offerings include:

- Learning to write European projects.
- Building international networks by connecting with European organizations.
- Enhancing your digital skills by creating educational content for young people, such as interactive escape rooms, games, apps, etc.
- Participating in environmental activities like tending to the garden, plants, cleaning green areas in the municipality, etc.
- Engaging in artistic activities to beautify the association and the neighborhood.
- Actively participating in sports competitions, either as a volunteer or a participant. We offer facilities like a gym, swimming pool, paddle tennis courts, football, basketball, etc.
- Assisting in the kitchen to prepare traditional meals and with cleaning tasks.
- Attending educational activities, courses, and other opportunities that may arise during your stay.
- Teaching classes and language exchanges with neighbors and young people interested in improving their language skills.

★ HOW WILL ROOM ASSIGNMENTS BE DETERMINED?

We offer rooms for 2, 3, and 4 people. Initially, room assignments will be made considering factors such as age, gender, and cultural backgrounds. As you become acquainted with each other, room changes are permitted, provided all parties involved are in agreement. Final approval for room changes will be granted by the activities coordinator.

★ ARE WASHING MACHINES AVAILABLE?

Yes, we have washing machines on the premises. However, due to the high demand, especially in our humid region, we also provide coin-operated washing machines and dryers at a nearby facility. This option allows you to efficiently wash and dry your clothes.



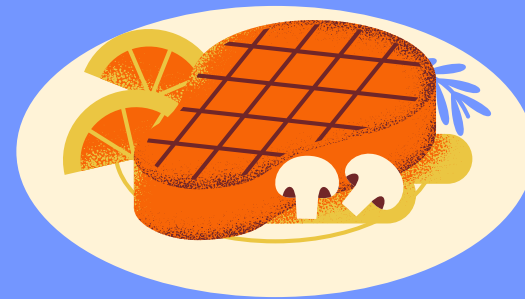
★ HOW ARE MEALS MANAGED?

We provide a restaurant service that prepares breakfast, lunch, and dinner daily. Additionally, packed meals are available for weekends, catering to those interested in excursions, outings, or late-night activities. This arrangement ensures both the participants and the kitchen staff have adequate rest.

★ ARE DIETARY INTOLERANCES TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT?

Yes, our kitchen team is fully equipped and authorized to accommodate special dietary needs. We request that you support your special requirements (such as allergies or intolerances) with a medical certificate.

Preferences without medical documentation will still be considered, although managing these preferences becomes the participant's responsibility if the kitchen is unable to accommodate them. This is due to the increasing variety of preferences observed in recent years, which presents challenges for our kitchen staff. We prioritize addressing genuine special needs and offer a nutritious variety of food. Participants with needs we consider excessive are expected to manage these needs with their pocket money.

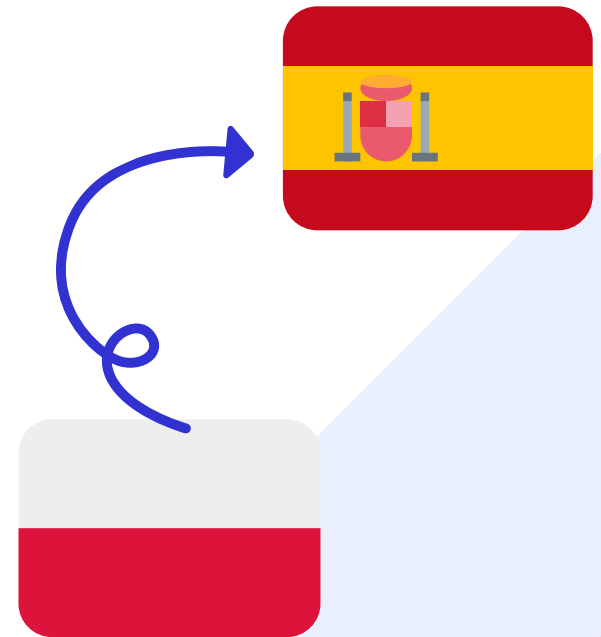

The prices for a car rental (in Santander or Bilbao airport) are around 20 euros per day, depending on the car's engine.

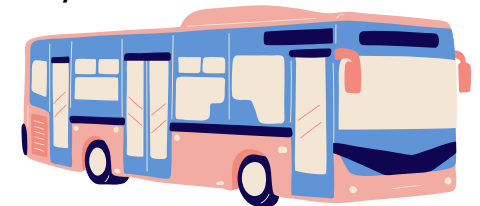

FROM BILBAO

Step 1: Bilbao Airport to San Mamés Bus Station: To get to Bilbao's bus station, there are buses from the airport every 30 minutes. The cost is approximately 1,45€. It is the public bus line (Bizkaibus) and the line number is A3247.

Step 2: San Mamés Bus Station to Santander Bus Station. Buy tickets at ALSA company, approximately 6,90€. Please consult the time schedules on the website.

TAXI - BILBAO TO SARÓN

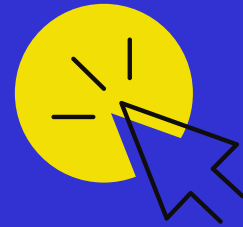
